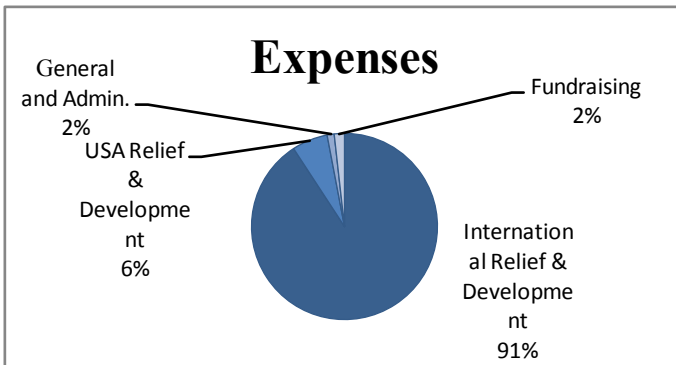
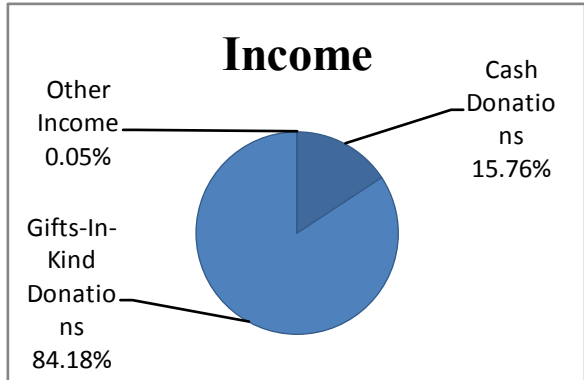
## Gifts-In-Kind
