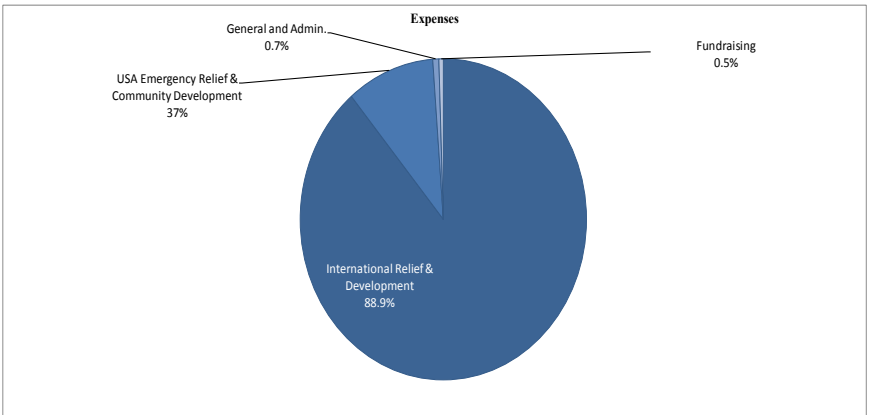
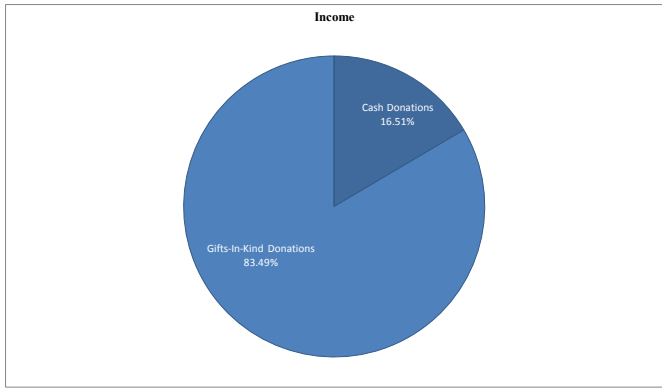
Gifts-In-Kind
