Non-government employees

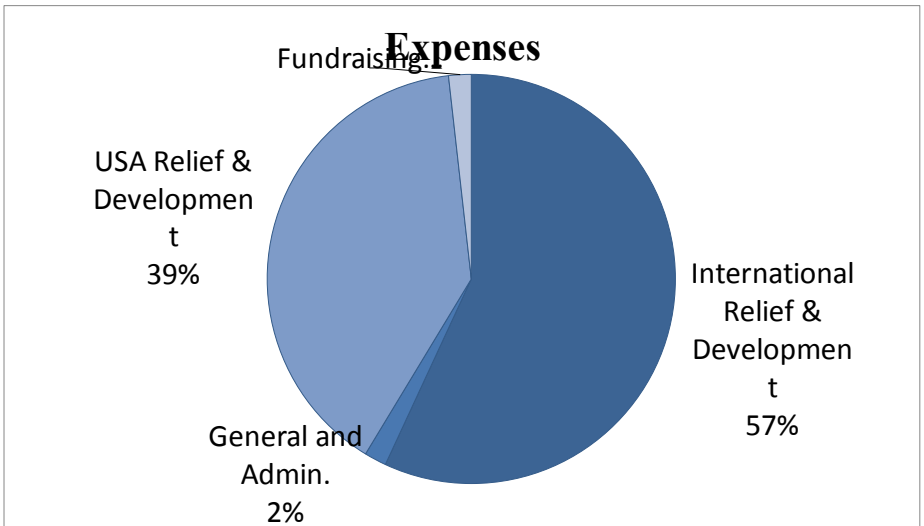
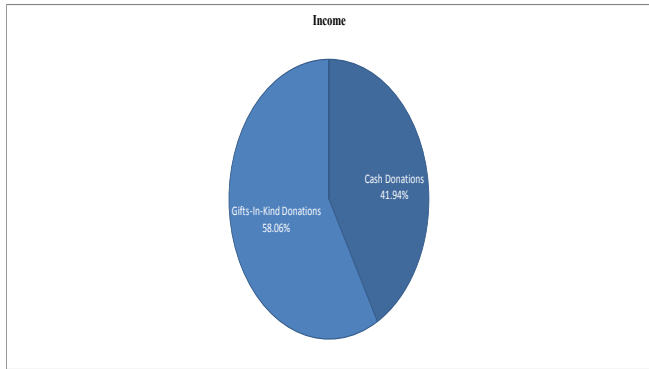
