Nazarene Compassionate Ministries Inc. (NCM Inc.) completed a successful year in 2018. Highlights include the Liberia Women and Girls Empowerment Project where local churches in Monrovia are creating opportunities for women who are vulnerable and living in poverty to realize their potential through vocational training, skills building workshops, and savings groups. Through these integrated approaches, churches aim to: 1) equip women with skills that enable them to buy what they need for their families and escape the humiliation of dependence on others; 2) help women understand and experience their God-given dignity and value; and 3) connect women to supportive relationships that offer social-emotion support, practical help, and spiritual encouragement. Additionally NCM Inc. continues to facilitate services for persons living with HIV/AIDS through a network of health clinics in eSwatini through the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and The International Center for AIDS Care and Treatment Programs.

NCM Inc. continues to be a strategic partner for the Church of the Nazarene and appreciates all of our partners in ministry: Fawn Grove Compassion Center, Convoy of Hope, Hands of Hope Northwest, United States Agency for International Development (USAID), Kudjip Nazarene Hospital, Global Aid Network, and Sacramento Compassion Center.

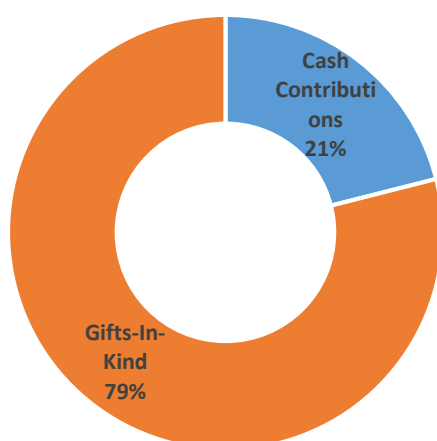

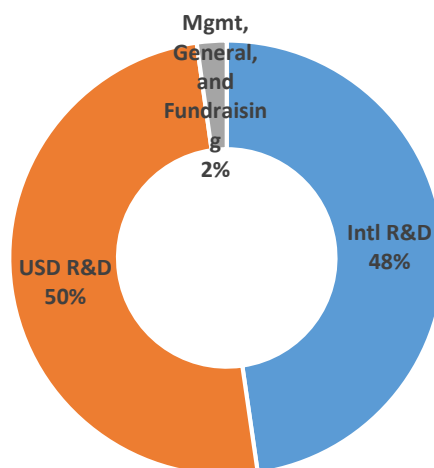
