CEO Letter

Nazarene Compassionate Ministries Inc. (NCM Inc.) completed a successful year in 2019. Highlights include the ongoing capacity building & assessment at country offices in Eswatini, Nepal, and Sri Lanka, with ongoing engagement in Bangladesh, Liberia, Sierra Leone, and Zambia. NCM Inc. assessment builds toward NCM Inc. High Capacity Office Certification by focusing on the steps of: Develop, Strengthen, and Equip. Geographical focus continues to be in South Asia and various fields on the Africa region.

We continued to see strong work in HIV/AIDS and preparation for new healthcare initiatives throughout Africa. Through ICAP (Columbia)/Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, NCM Eswatini will continue its role in strengthening the local capacity to deliver sustainable quality assured universal coverage of clinical HIV services in Manzini Region by worked closely with 12 high priority clinics to enhance linkages, tracking and follow-up of patients lost to care.

In Year 5, the project will implement new activities under a Faith-Based Community Initiative. Multi-denominational faith structures will serve as vehicles to increase HIV self-testing specifically among men, encourage and link positive clients to care, promote positive living adherence to treatment plans, and provide prevention education on Gender-Based Violence among children 14 years and younger. Additionally, faith leaders will be trained in "HIV 101", and spiritual counseling and psychosocial support will be available to survivors of GBV through pastors and other forged partnerships with key gender-based violence organizations

An additional bright spot is in Monrovia, Liberia in the Empowering Women & Girls with Dignity Project. The project provides 200 women with vocational skills (catering, tailoring, soap-making/fabric tie-dye), savings and credit groups, business skills training, and life skills training. NCMI providing project management support and monitoring/evaluation. We will see the completion of the first rounds of vocational training courses in February and graduation of students in March 2020.

NCM Inc. continues to be a strategic partner for the Church of the Nazarene and appreciates all of our partners in ministry: Fawn Grove Compassion Center, Convoy of Hope, Hands of Hope Northwest, United States Agency for International Development (USAID), Kudjip Nazarene Hospital, Global Aid Network, Sacramento Compassion Center, LifeNet Intl., and World Hope Intl.




