Standard Five - Match Strategy

Policy 5.1 Match Strategy Policy and Criteria

- It is this agency's policy that the mentoring program shall have a well-documented Mentor/Mentee Match Strategy Policy and may consist of the following Match Criteria:
 - Gender and Age
 - Same gender matches
 - Adult Mentor/Youth Mentee Matches a minimum age difference of five years
 - Teen Mentor/Youth Mentee Matches a minimum age difference of 3 years
 - o Race
 - This agency actively recruits for a mentor applicant pool that reflects the racial and ethnic composition of the families in our program
 - This agency will not make match decision based solely upon race, however, this agency recognizes that some mentees may need the kind of rapport that comes from same-race matching as indicated and stated within the mentee application, mentee interests and parent/guardian feedback
 - Personality Attributes and Characteristics and Interests
 - Good judgment and instinct must be exercised to draw information and insight from an array of sources, including: mentor, mentee and parent interviews, mentor reference checks, mentee application, feedback from mentoring staff, direct observation and personality assessment tools.
 - Personality assessments may be useful to help facilitate matching
 - Residence/Location
 - Ideally, mentor and mentee will live near enough to each other to share a familiarity of each other's neighborhoods.
 - Availability
 - Because it is essential for mentors and mentees to meet on a regular basis to develop a healthy relationship, matches are made between mentor/mentee who have compatible schedules.
 - Organic Match Gravitation
 - In some instances, a natural, organic matching process has occurred between a mentor/mentee through other relationship venues and they seek to develop a formal mentor/mentee relationship, thus organic gravitation matches will be honored.
- It is the policy of this agency, that whenever possible, a Match Event will be held to observe potential matches before making a final decision
- It is the policy of this agency that the Mentoring Director/Coordinator will make the final decision/approval of all mentor/mentee matches
- It is the policy of this agency that Match Rationale is documented in the match file (mentor file and mentee file)

Policy 5.2 Written Match Agreement

It is the policy of this agency that a Written Match Agreement shall be developed, signed and implemented in each mentor/mentee match and maintained in the Mentor File and Mentee File

- It is the policy of this agency that the Written Match Agreement shall contain the following components:
 - Mentor/Mentee Contact Expectations
 - o Documentation of the Match Criteria/Rationale
 - o Documentation of the Match Conditions
 - Signatures (mentor, mentee, parent/guardian, mentoring staff)
